Call for Workshops

The 8th *Vienna Anthropology Days 2013 (Tage der Kultur- und Sozialanthropologie)* will be held in Vienna on June 6 and 7, 2013. They are jointly organized by the Department of Social and Cultural Anthropology of the University of Vienna, the Institute for Social Anthropology of the Austrian Academy of Sciences (ISA), and the Museum of Ethnology in Vienna.

The *Vienna Anthropology Days* were introduced in 2005 with the aim of intensifying communication between anthropologists based in Vienna and of increasing the visibility of their work. Early-stage researchers (with a finished MA thesis or pursuing their PhD studies) are particularly invited to present their work, including researchers from abroad. Furthermore, the *Vienna Anthropology Days* offer the possibility to present ongoing research projects as well as undergraduate research undertaken in the context of field research seminars.

As in previous years, we also call for approaches going beyond the conventional workshop format (art installations, photo exhibitions etc.). We appreciate original and innovative ideas.

The call for workshops is open until February 22nd 2013. To propose a workshop please send the following information to tagederksa@univie.ac.at:

- Title of the proposed workshop and abstract of the topic (up to 300 words) in English or German. We welcome presentations in German and English; workshops may be offered in either language or mixed.
- Name, institutional affiliation and email address of the workshop coordinator. The coordinators will be responsible for the organization and moderation of their workshops.

The **call for papers** will be opened with the announcement of the workshops on the Department's website on March 7, 2013. Proposed papers must include the author's name and email address, the title of the paper and an abstract of up to 300 words and must be submitted to the respective workshop coordinators.
